From Leduc:

- Hwy 2A South to the Hwy 13 intersection (lights)
- Turn left (East) towards Camrose, past the hospital to the business park.
- Look for Home Hardware distribution center – turn right (South)
- Continue South for about ½ mile to the end of the parking lot.
- Go right at the end of the parking lot to the “Knights of Columbus” diamonds

Beaumont - Games are at Four Seasons Park. Take the Beaumont exit past Leduc to the east on Highway 625. At Beaumont there is a set of lights at the highway. Turn left into town. There is one set of lights at the Lubex that you go straight through. At the second set of lights turn left on 43ave. A few blocks down is our high school on your left. Turn left right before the high school into there parking lot. The diamond is located right behind the high school.

Hobbema- The ball diamond the mosquitos are playing at is located in Ermineskin Reserve as there are 4 reserves in Hobbema. The diamond is located behind the Ermineskin High School. The school is bright with a very large teepee in the middle you can't miss it when traveling south on highway 2A. It is a right turn coming from the north.

Pipestone - The ball diamond is at Pipestone School. No bleachers, bring a lawn chair.

From highway 2 Southbound, take the Millet / Mulhurst turn onto highway 616 and go right towards Mulhurst. Follow the road to a stop sign and turn left onto highway 795. Follow the road a very short distance to the Pipestone 795 Café, turn left and the school and ball diamond are a short distance on the left. It is about a 40 min. drive from Beaumont.

From Millet take highway 616 west. Follow the road to a stop sign and turn left onto highway 795. Follow the road a very short distance to the Pipestone 795 Café, turn left and the school and ball diamond are a short distance on the left. It is about a 25 min. drive.

From Calmar take 795 south. Follow the highway until you reach the Pipestone Café, turn left and the school and ball diamond are a short distance on the left. It is about a 25 min. drive.

From Wetaskiwin take highway 13 west to highway 795. Turn right, follow the highway until you reach the Pipestone Café, turn right and the school and ball diamond are a short distance on the left. It is about a 35 min. drive.
